

Fish rhymes

pictures of the Icelandic version on the next page

What you need:

- cards with rhymes (pictures and the word written below) I did the cards 7x10 cm
- laminator machine and plastic
- carton paper that is thick as the laminator machine handles
- scissors
- basket for the cards

What to do:

- find on the internet rhyme pictures and put them into the frames in a word file. I found 22 rhymes with three word so the cards are 66 all together (f.e. house,mouse, louse)
- print on the carton paper and clip
- put in plastic and through the laminator machine. Cut again.

The game:

- Played like the game Go fish (at least in Iceland). If f.e. four are playing each one drags 5 cards and has them on hand. One asks at a time the whole group f.e. if someone has a card that rhymes with house. If one has mouse and another louse they both give their card. Then the player has full group and put the cards away. Then he gets a new card from the group on the table. If no one has what rhymes with house they say FISH and the player drags a new card from the group on the table. The game goes on until all the rhymes are in a group on the table.

Note:

- Most of the things I make are for kids in preschool (In Iceland kids are from the age 2-6 in preschool) This game can be made also for kids that can read and then no pictures are needed. You can then find more rhymes and even have four of each instead of three like here.
